



How to prepare the cat for the cat hotel?

The cats that have to stay in the cat hotel should be healthy and well taken care of. It is very important that the cat is treated and protected against external and internal parasites.

External parasites are fleas and ticks. Fleas can be brought home on owners' shoes. Internal parasites are worms, and all cats should be treated two or three times a year. Anti-parasitic products are available in good pet-shops. We recommend the following products, or similar:

- ✓ [Bayer Advantage](#) against external parasites (spot-on, to be applied on the back of neck)
- ✓ [Bayer Profender](#) (spot-on) or [Bayer Drontal](#) (tablet) against internal parasites

[Bayer Advocate](#) is the cumulative product, against all parasites (spot-on).

At least two days before bringing the cat...

- ✓ treat the cat against parasites
- ✓ brush the cat thoroughly
- ✓ trim cat's claws [YouTube](#)
- ✓ take out the carrier, and place it in a visible spot in cat's living space.

On the day of cat's arrival...

It is best to transport the cat during low-traffic periods or weekends. Put the cat in a carrier at least one hour in advance. Treat the cat as usual, without excitement or nervousness – the cats can feel the owner's stress, and they do not like unusual situations. Pack the following items:

- ✓ International Certificate of Vaccination ("passport")
- ✓ hand-filled and signed document [Cat Boarding Agreement](#) and personal ID's
- ✓ cat's favourite blanket, pillow or toy with familiar smells
- ✓ small amount of cat's used litter.

Before leaving the house, check that the carrier door is locked and secure. See you!
